This booklet should help you to settle in as quickly and as easily as possible. It contains some information which may prove useful in your first few days and weeks at Wavell.

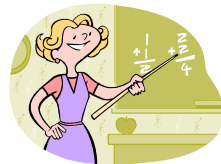


Hey New Kid...WELCOME!!
