- Average mobility rate:
 - Primary 66%
 - Secondary 56%
- Average number of schools attended:
 - Primary 3.2
 - Secondary 4.9 (Yr 9)
- Pupils attending one school
 - Primary 8.7%
 - Secondary 4%
- Pupils attending 3 or more schools:
 - Primary 68%
 - Secondary 96%
- Pupils attending 5 or more schools:
 - Primary 13%
 - Secondary 40%
