Belize Service Children's School was opened in 1989 in response to the Education Reform Act 1988, which instigated a national curriculum for schools in England and Wales. Service Children's Education, recommended that a Services' school should be set up in Belize to keep service children in step with teaching in the UK.

The school can accommodate up to twenty + children aged 4 to 11 years that is Foundation Stage 2 to Year 6. There are three full-time teachers. Teacher assistants are employed subject to need and availability.

In common with service schools all over the world, Toucan School provides places for the children of all entitled personnel, military and civilian. In addition, places may be available for non-entitled children, who pay a termly fee.

The purpose of this booklet is to introduce you to Toucan School. In it you will read about our curriculum and how we manage our children's learning. There is also other information about the school. If however, you have any queries please do not hesitate to write or call in.

I hope you will find this booklet interesting and informative. I look forward to meeting you and hope you and your family have a pleasant stay in Belize.

TOUCAN SCHOOL MISSION STATEMENT

We at Belize Service Children's School aim to provide a teaching and learning environment in which all children may achieve their maximum potential across the spectrum of the curriculum and in their interaction with others. We hope to promote the spiritual, moral, cultural, mental and physical development of our pupils and prepare them for the experiences of adult life. We aim to:

- Deliver the English National Curriculum in a well-matched and properly differentiated manner.
- Enable every child to achieve their maximum level of attainment.
- Encourage children to be active, independent learners.
- Develop personal confidence and high self-esteem.
- Develop awareness of a corporate identity within the group, school and community.
- Create, develop and foster a strong home/school partnership.
- Make children aware of all the opportunities which are open to them regardless of race, religion, disability or gender.
- Ensure that all children who attend Toucan School are given the opportunity to make the most of their time in a Central American country.

SCHOOL MANAGEMENT

Delegation of Responsibilities

- Responsibility for all Service Children's Schools is vested in the Secretary of State for Defence.
- The implementation of policy, organisation and administration is the responsibility of the Service Children's Education Agency Headquarters, Wegberg. The contact address is; Chief Executive, HQ SCE, BFPO 40.
- BATSUB has a responsibility as Parent Unit for local administration purposes and the COMD has representation on the School's Governance Committee (SGC).
- The day to day management of the school is the responsibility of the Headteacher who, along with the assistant teachers, is appointed by Service Children's Education.

School Governance Committee

All SCE schools have a School Governance Committee (SGC). The SGC performs a similar role to that of a governing body but its role is advisory. The SGC is comprised of:

The SGC meets once each term, the dates and times of meetings will be published. If there is any matter you wish to raise, please speak to a member of the committee. The present incumbents for this year are listed in the addendum to this document. If you are interested in serving on the SGC please contact the Chairman.

The school has a school website that outlines a variety of information that may be of use to parents. It includes various details regarding assessment and events that have taken place in the school.

School Organisation

The Toucan School is resourced for up to 25 children between the ages 4 to 11 years that is Foundation Stage 2 to Y6. The children are grouped according to age and ability, they may also work with older or younger pupils according to the task e.g.: paired reading. Work may be carried out individually or in co-operative work groups.

The school day begins at 8:00 a.m. and finishes at 1:40 p.m.

Session One 08:00 - 09:45

20 Minute Break



Session Two 10:05 - 11:30

20 Minute Break



Session Three 11:50 - 1:40

(KSI children will also have a short break during session 3 if the timetable allows)

Snacks and drinks may be consumed at break times. Please do not send fizzy drinks or sweets. We encourage healthy options for children's lunch box. Please ensure that snacks are carried in a secure lunch box, which your child can manage.

School hats must be worn during breaks when playing outside.

Curriculum

Toucan School follows the National Curriculum of England. There are four core subjects: English, Maths, Science and ICT and seven foundation subjects: Design Technology, History, Geography, Art and Design, PE and Music. Religious Education (RE) is also taught in line with SCE's own document SACRE. RE is of a broadly Christian nature but includes study of other religions. Parents who do not wish their children to take part in RE may withdraw them. However, they

must arrange for their children to be supervised during the time that they are withdrawn.

Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) and Citizenship are included in the school's curriculum following the QCA guidance for schools.

If you wish to know more about the content of the National Curriculum please speak to the Headteacher.

Toucan School uses the New Frameworks that have been introduced for numeracy and Literacy.

Curriculum 2000 identifies six key skills which DFES & QCA have embedded in the National Curriculum. These skills are:

- Communicating
- Applying number
- Using IT
- Working with Others
- Improving own Learning and Performance
- Solving Problems

They will help children improve their learning performance in education, work and life.

The policies and ethos of Toucan School support the teaching and use of these skills across the curriculum.

Standard Assessment Tasks and Test (SATs)

All primary school children in English primary schools are tested at age 11 years Y6. The Qualifications and Curriculum Authority (QCA) send papers to all schools; these are administered during May each year. The Y6 tests are administered by class teachers but are sent to UK for external marking. Parents are informed of their children's SAT scores as part of the end of year report in July. It is the policy of this school to administer these assessment tasks to all children of the correct age including non-entitled children. There are no results posted for this year in this prospectus as there was only one entrant and this would breach confidentiality.

Reporting to Parents

i. Three Week Interview

Approximately three weeks after entry parents are invited into school to discuss their child's initial progress.



ii. Parent-Teacher Consultations

Parent-Teacher Consultations are held each term. Parents are able to make an appointment to come into school to look at their children's work and to discuss progress. This is an excellent opportunity for parents to look around the school and to see some of the work that the children have been doing. We believe that Parent-Teacher dialogue is an integral part of a child's education. Should you wish to discuss your child's progress at any time other than the consultation afternoons, please do not hesitate to contact the school's secretary to make an appointment. Every last Tuesday of the month parents are invited into school to read with the children and view the work they have been doing.

iii. Transfer and End of Year Reports

At the end of the school year, or on transfer to another school, each child is given a comprehensive report on their progress with recommendations for future development. Children write their own comment about their work in school and parents are also invited to make a written contribution.

Support for Special Needs

All children are assessed on arrival. They are then placed in the most appropriate group. Children who require additional support may be identified at this time or at a later date. Following need identification an initial concerns questionnaire will be completed and the parents will be informed. After a parental interview the child will be placed on the Special Educational Needs (SEN) register at School Action. They will then receive suitable support in lessons. On occasions individuals or small groups will be withdrawn for extra support in areas where a need has been identified.

SEN reviews will be held on a termly basis. The parents will be invited to attend each review. A decision will be made to: (a) remove from the list, (b) action, (c) action plus.

If further help is required the school will communicate with HQ SCE. Children will not be able to be admitted to Toucan School if we are unable to meet any specific SEN needs where outside agencies are involved. This is checked before parents are posted to BATSUB.

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

Joining Toucan School

Service and other entitled children should be enrolled into the school on arrival in Belize.

Children are admitted annually to Early Years Foundation Stage 2 classes at Toucan School. Three introductory sessions are organized at the end of each summer term for the prospective FS2 children. These are important familiarization sessions for them.

A child is eligible for admission from the beginning of the school year following his/her fifth birthday. For this purpose, the school year is defined as beginning on 1 September, regardless of actual term dates.

Children becoming five whilst in Belize may be enrolled into the school during the academic year in which they will be five.

When there are vacancies non-entitled children (NEC) may be admitted on a fee-paying basis. The parents of NECs should apply to the Headteacher at the school who will advise them about availability of places, admission arrangements and current fees.

Leaving Toucan School

We appreciate as much notice as possible of departure. When a child leaves school, mid year transfer documents and reports have to be prepared in isolation. Please advise us as soon as your leaving date is confirmed.

When transferring to another school it is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that documentation is transferred to the new school. You will be given a file, which will include a copy of your child's report and a portfolio of work; these must be handed to the new Headteacher. Where possible records are also transferred electronically to the next school.

School Uniform

The school colours are blue and white. Some items of uniform are available for purchase from the school * as below. Material for school dresses may be purchased in Belize City and the seamstress on the Price Barracks will make dresses to fit for a small fee. Alternatively, parents may prefer to purchase clothing from UK stores such as Marks and Spencer and British Home Stores, which have dresses and polo shirts of the preferred style and colour.

Uniform items are:

Pale blue or white blouse/shirt or pale blue polo shirt.*

Navy blue shorts, skirt or culottes.

Navy blue and white gingham dresses (small check)

Pale blue or white school T-shirts with school badge.*

School hat.*

Sensible shoes and white or blue socks.



PE Kit:

Pale blue/turquoise or white school T-shirt.*

Navy blue shorts.*

School hat*

Training shoes for games, light shoes or bare feet for gym, dance and movement.

Swimming Kit:

One piece costume, large towel, handkerchief, comb or brush and suntan lotion.

Please Note:

- Open toed, sling back or backless sandals are not allowed.
- Long hair must be held back and fancy multicoloured adornments are not allowed.
- Decorative jewellery must not be worn to school. A simple wristwatch may be worn but must be removed for all activities and is entirely the responsibility of the wearer. For children with pierced ears only studs or sleepers are permissible.

School Book Bag

School reading books are carried to and from home on a daily basis. The school has a book bag, which is designed to protect books in transit. Parents may purchase book bags from the secretary along with certain items of uniform.

Absence and Illness

If your child will be absent from school please telephone the secretary, send a note or call in. We are required by law to record all unauthorised absences, so please inform us promptly stating the reason for the absence.

Absences for the last school year can be found at Annex D.

We expect that family holidays will be taken when the school is closed. If leave has to be taken during term time leave of absence must be requested in writing. The Headteacher may grant up to ten days authorised absence in exceptional circumstances. Children should attend school in term time unless absence is unavoidable.

If your child is taken ill or has an accident during school time we may need to contact you so please ensure we have an up to date day time contact number.

Recorder lessons

There is an opportunity for the children to learn the recorder. Recorders, books and tuition are provided as part of the curriculum. Practice at home is essential to progress. We appreciate the support of parents. You will be notified of the days on which your child will need to bring their recorder to school. FS2 children do not take part in recorder lessons.



PE Days

Please ensure your child has a change of clothing on PE days. The school T-shirt is to be worn for PE with navy blue shorts. Training shoes should be worn for games and lightweight footwear or bare feet for gym, not training shoes. School T-shirt and shorts can be purchased from the school secretary.



All the children will go swimming once a week, weather permitting. They will need a one-piece costume, a large towel, a handkerchief and a brush or comb, all in a bag which is easy for them to carry.

School hats must be worn for all outdoor activities.

Library

Toucan School has a wide range of fiction and non-fiction books available for loan from the library. The children have a designated time for changing these books every Friday.



Homework

Toucan School homework policy follow DfES Guidelines for primary schools.

Children will bring home a reading book and a home reading record for parents/carers to complete everyday. They should spend time reading their book and being read to on a daily basis.



Homework tasks will be set on Tuesday to be completed and returned to school by the following Wednesday. These will include spellings, maths activities, specific written tasks related to topic work etc. Full explanations accompany such tasks, but if you are in any doubt please ask. In the main, these tasks are interactive and open-ended. Please feel free to extend the tasks as you and your child see fit.

Please support your children in helping with and extending their homework tasks. We do not expect children to spend too much time completing their homework. Please see guidelines in the Homework Policy for the approximate times children are expected to take completing their homework.



Discipline & Behaviour

At Toucan School we aim to promote positive behaviour in our pupils by encouraging good conduct and by creating an environment in which appropriate behaviour can flourish. The school recognises its responsibility in this respect but stresses that it can only be achieved through partnership with pupils and parents.

Toucan School has a Behaviour and Discipline Policy, and a policy for the use of force to control or restrain pupils, which are available for parents to see should they wish.

Essentially this policy stresses the roles that teachers, parents and pupils must play in the maintenance of good order in the school. It also outlines action to be taken in cases of inappropriate behaviour, from a verbal reprimand by a teacher to possible exclusion in severe circumstances.

Corporal punishment is not used in any SCE School.

We are pleased to report that standards of behaviour and conduct are high at Toucan School and it is our aim, in partnership with parents and children, to maintain this situation.

Complaints

If parents have a complaint to make about any aspect of our service there are a number of alternative approaches they are able to make.

1. The Classteacher. The Classteacher is always the first point of contact for parents. If a parent has cause for concern about any matter concerning their child's education they should make an appointment to discuss it with the Classteacher.
2. The Headteacher. The Headteacher is always available and willing to discuss any concerns that a parent may have. Parents should telephone or call in to make an appointment.
3. SGC Representative. The parents are represented by a parent representative on the School Governance Committee. A parent with a complaint about any aspect of the school may approach their SGC Rep. and ask them to raise the matter at the next SGC meeting.
4. Chairman of the SGC. QM BATSUB is chairman of the SGC and as such is available to hear any complaint about the service that the school is offering. Parents may telephone him to make an appointment to discuss school matters.
5. Competent Authority. HQ SCE has ultimate responsibility for Toucan School. Parents wishing to discuss their complaint at the highest level should contact Mr. D. Wadsworth, Chief Executive Service Children's Education, HQ SCE, BFPO 40.

Home-School Agreement

Parents, children and teachers are asked to sign the Home-School Agreement in which we all agree to uphold the ethos of the school.



Internet Agreement

Parents (and children of a suitable age) will be asked to sign an internet agreement form which includes rules for safe internet use.



Medicines in School

Only in exceptional circumstances should medicines be brought into the school. Should the need arise for you to bring medication to school e.g. a respirator for Asthma, such items must be placed in a container clearly labelled with the child's name and given to the school secretary. Within the container must be explicit instructions on the administration of the medication.



ALL MEDICATION MUST BE HANDED TO THE SCHOOL SECRETARY ON ARRIVAL FOR SAFEKEEPING.

Sex Education

Sex Education is delivered through National Curriculum Science Attainment Target Two - Life and Living Processes. Other relevant and appropriate sex education may be approached through other areas of the curriculum, for example as part of a topic, in story time, in assembly or in PSHE.

School Outings

Local outings, within the camp will not normally be notified separately. A local outing consent form is part of the registration procedure.

For outings further afield, or which are outside normal school hours, you will receive separate notice. The children will be required to wear school uniform on such outings unless otherwise stated. Where numbers permit parents are allowed to attend trips and help out. We also welcome parents into school to

offer any talents that they have that would be appropriate to share with the children.
